When a child is violent – the project (2020-2022) in Finland supports families to find ways to reduce the violent behaviour of special children or young people.

When a child is violent – the project seeks solutions for the lives of families where a child or young person under the age of 25 with special needs behaves violently towards other members of their family. The children or young people may have a developmental disability, neuropsychiatric problems, or challenges with understanding and learning.

When a child is violent – the main focus of the project is on individual and family guidance activities. The project operates in the Pirkanmaa region of Finland.

Project objectives:

- Violence perpetrated by a special child or young person is reduced in the family.
- Living in a shared home is safe for all family members.
- Domestic violence committed by a special child or young person becomes visible.
- The service system responds to the needs of families in terms of violence prevention work.
